Subject: Gender Pronouns and University Business Cards Update

USG embraces a culture grounded in respect, civility, and inclusion and therefore is committed to using language that honors the diversity of our employees. Consistent with these values, USG staff now have the option of articulating and including their gender pronouns on business cards. For greater clarity, a gender pronoun is a pronoun some individuals use as a form of self-identification.

We have attached a UMCP Printing Services <u>form</u> which lists the five sets of gender pronouns that are approved for use on our business cards. If you want to include gender pronouns on your business cards, we encourage you to contact the <u>Copy Center</u>. However, please note, this is not a template requirement.
